

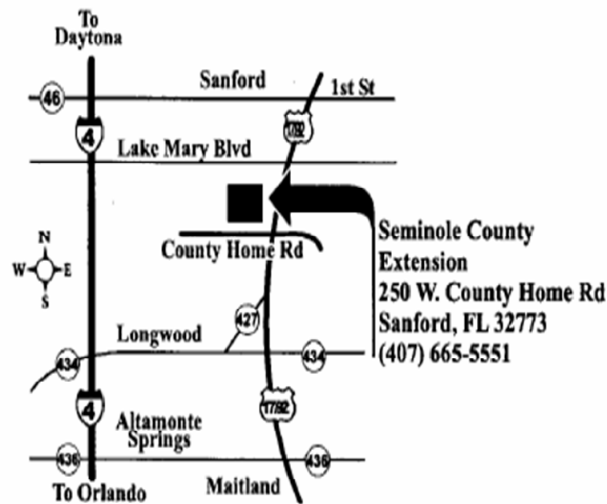

OVERVIEW



Best Management Practices (BMPs) were written by the Green Industry in partnership with Florida Government agencies and University of Florida.

The BMPs cover proper fertilization, pest control, irrigation, and cultural practices for landscape and pest control professionals. Knowledge of appropriate fertilizer rates, sources, and application methods can greatly reduce potential pollution of ground and surface water.

- Supervisors & Employees in Lawn Care, Pest Control, or Landscape Industry
- Municipal Parks & Recreation Facility Supervisors and Employees
- Irrigation Industry Workers
- Retail Facility Employees who sell fertilizers
- City & County Planning Staff, Environmental Depart. or Water Quality
- Builders and Developers, Landscape Designers and Architects

IS YOUR COMPANY CERTIFIED?

Certification offered by University of Florida/IFAS is voluntary; although, mandatory by some cities and counties. Beginning January 1, 2014, any person applying commercial fertilizer to an urban landscape must be certified through this program and incur a fee.
