The Green Industries Best Management Practices (BMPs) are designed to preserve and protect Florida's water resources from non-point-source pollution. The BMPs cover proper fertilization, pest control, irrigation, and cultural practices for landscape and pest control professionals. Knowledge of appropriate fertilizer rates, sources, and application methods can greatly reduce any potential non-point source pollution of Florida's ground and surface waters. Although adoption of the BMPs is voluntary at this time, training in the BMPs is recommended and class participants completing the all of the training and both the pre and post tests (*Note: MUST pass the post test*) will receive a certificate and be placed on a list of BMP certified individuals at the University of Florida.
