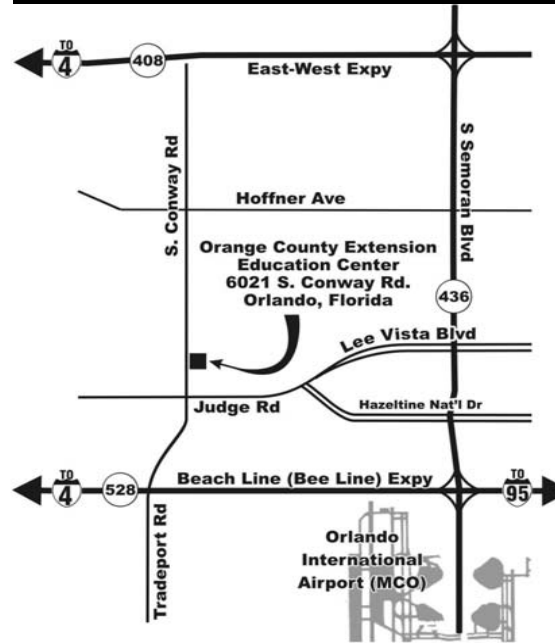

A license is necessary for each commercial landscape maintenance person who applies pesticides to ornamental plant beds.
