Exams are administered **only** with a completed application, photo and license fee or if you choose to expedite the process on Review and Exam Day you can bring in an approval letter from the Bureau of Entomology & Pest Control. - **Limited Certification for Governmental & Private Applicators – Lawn & Ornamental** - A license is necessary for each government employee, business owner or their employees who applies pesticides outdoors of a government or business owned buildings. <http://www.flaes.org/pdf/lmtdpckt.pdf>
- **Limited Certification for Governmental & Private Applicators – Structural** - A license is necessary for each government employee, business owner or their employees who applies pesticides indoors of a government or business owned buildings. <http://www.flaes.org/pdf/lmtdpckt.pdf>
- **Limited Certification for Commercial Landscape Maintenance** - A license is necessary for each commercial landscape maintenance person who applies pesticides to ornamental plant beds. <http://www.flaes.org/pdf/lndspckt.pdf>

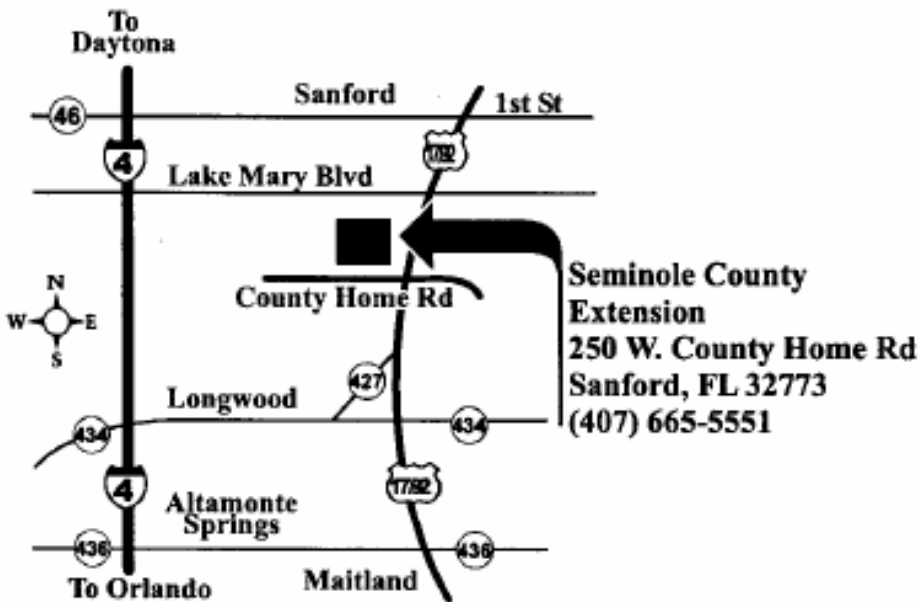

We are approximately 30 minutes north of Orlando.

To get to the Seminole County Extension Service via I-4, take the **Lake Mary/Heathrow Exit - 98** and head (east) on **Lake Mary Boulevard**, approximately 4.5 miles to **17-92**.

At the intersection of **Lake Mary Boulevard** and **17-92**, turn right, (south) and go approximately 1.4 miles.

You will pass Flea World on your left and the next traffic light is the intersection of **17-92** and **County Home Road**. The Humane Society will be on your left at the red light and the Fire Station will be kitty-corner to your right.

Turn right (west) onto **County Home Road** and continue forward .10 of a mile, go past the Fire Station, to the second driveway on the right. You will see the signs for:
