OSCEOLA COUNTY EXTENSION SERVICE, KISSIMMEE, FL. – MAY 20, 2009

Private Applicator Agricultural - This license will be issued to persons who apply or supervise the application of restricted use pesticides for agricultural production such as vegetable, fruit, or cattle farm, sod farm or nursery and greenhouse. You will need to take **both** the General Standards exam and the Private Agricultural Applicator exam.

Ornamental and Turf – This license is for persons employed on a golf course, park, athletic field, or cemetery. You will need to take **both** the General Standards exam and the Ornamental and Turf exam.

Training manuals cover exam questions (all exams SM1-Core), SM7 & SM38-Ornamental and Turf, SM53-Private. They can be ordered at 800-226-1764. *If you plan to take an exam, you should study the training manuals.*

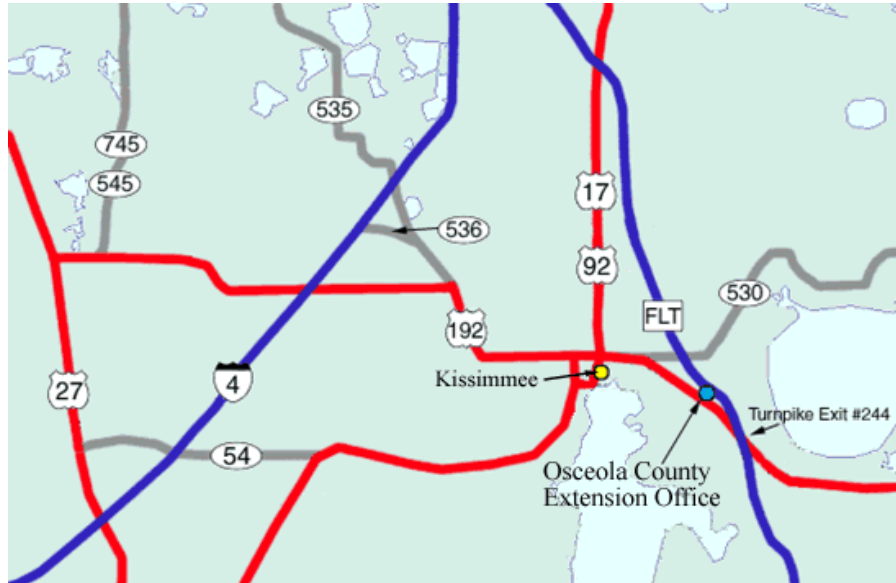

Directions

From I-4 Westbound, take Exit #77, to Florida's Turnpike South. See below for Turnpike Southbound.

From I-4 Eastbound, take Exit #65, Osceola Parkway (\$1.25 toll), proceed east 9.1 miles to Michigan Avenue (third traffic light after the toll booth). Turn right on Michigan Avenue to US-192 (at the fourth traffic light). Turn left and follow US-192 to Bill Beck Blvd. Turn left at the first intersection onto Chief Osceola Trail and then right onto Kissimmee Valley Lane. Use the parking lot in front of the Extension Offices.

From Florida's Turnpike Northbound, take Exit #242 (Kissimmee-St. Cloud), turn left (west) onto US-192; go approximately two miles to stop light at Bill Beck Blvd. Turn right. The main entrance to Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on left. Turn left at the first intersection onto Chief Osceola Trail and then right onto Kissimmee Valley Lane. Use the parking lot in front of the Extension Offices.

From Florida's Turnpike Southbound, take Exit #244 (Kissimmee-St. Cloud), turn right (west) onto US-192; go through stop light at Simpson Road to next stop light at Bill Beck Blvd. (approximately one mile). Turn right. The main entrance to Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on left. Turn left at the first intersection onto Chief Osceola Trail and then right onto Kissimmee Valley Lane. Use the parking lot in front of the Extension Offices.

From Orlando International Airport, follow South Exit signs from the airport. Proceed south on Boggy Creek Road, go under toll road 417, then one mile to stop light (Circle K on one corner); turn right (name of street is still Boggy Creek Road). Follow this (name changes to Simpson Road to US-192, turn right, to next stoplight, Bill Beck Blvd, and turn right. The main entrance to Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on left. Turn left at the first intersection onto Chief Osceola Trail and then right onto Kissimmee Valley Lane. Use the parking lot in front of the Extension Offices.

From I-95 Northbound, take Exit #180, to US-192 West. Follow US-192 to Bill Beck Blvd. Turn right. Follow signs to main entrance. Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on left. Turn left at the first intersection onto Chief Osceola Trail and then right onto Kissimmee Valley Lane. Use the parking lot in front of the Extension Offices.

From I-95 Southbound, take Exit #205B, to Route 528, the Beeline Expressway. Exit the Beeline at Exit #26 to Route 417 west (the Greeneway). Exit 417 at Exit #17, to Boggy Creek Road south. Follow Boggy Creek one mile to stop light, turn right onto Boggy Creek Road to US-192 (approximately 5.3 miles) (street name changes to Simpson Road). Turn right on US-192, to next traffic light, Bill Beck Blvd., turn right. Follow signs to main entrance. Osceola Heritage Park is about one block on left.
